School starts at **8:20 am** School ends at **2:40 pm**

Our school day begins **PROMPTLY** at 8:20 am and ends at 2:40 pm therefore please arrive at school with your child at **8:10 am for drop off and 2:30 pm for pickup**. This will help ensure timely arrival and dismissal as well as support for your child's well-being.

Lateness - Arriving on time for school is an essential part of schooling. Students who are repeatedly late miss important work that begins as soon as the teacher and children reach the classroom. Lateness also causes a disruption to class work and leads to poor working habits. Parents should make sure that their children come to school on time. In the event of a problem that requires a child to arrive after 8:20 am, parents must send a note informing the teacher why the lateness occurred.

PLEASE NOTE: Students may not be dropped off or left unattended at school prior to **8:20 am** unless they are attending the breakfast program. This is a matter of safety and security. School personnel are not available to supervise youngsters before 8:20 am each morning.

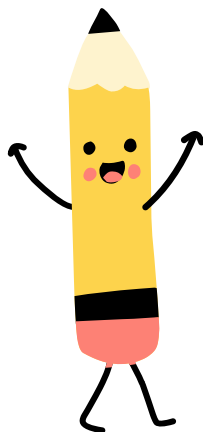

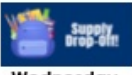
